SAFDF has established a scholarship fund named after Nelda Guerrero Drury, the founder and "patron saint" of the festival. Nelda Drury Scholarships are awarded to individuals to attend and actively participate in SAFDF. They are intended to encourage attendance by new dancers and by dancers who have demonstrated potential to benefit their local folk dance group through what they learn at SAFDF.

General information

- Scholarship recipients must be full-time registrants at SAFDF.
- Scholarship recipients are expected to attend dance teaching sessions and to volunteer for tasks at SAFDF. (These tasks include lunch setup, concert box office, and concert ushering.)
- The scholarship covers only the admission to the workshop. Extras such as dance review DVDs, lunches, and teacher music sales are not included.
